OPSONAT spag. oral drops — PEKANA's Top-selling Medication in Germany

PEKANA considers **OPSONAT spag. oral drops** its "flagship" remedy. Developed to reduce systemic inflammation and change the biological terrain – with a special focus on mucous and serous membranes – this remedy supports treatment of conditions that end in "itis." For example, practitioners have found OPSONAT highly beneficial as a part of a protocol in treating all types of inflammatory gastrointestinal (GI) tract problems, including gastritis and colitis, as well as arthritis, urinary tract infections (UTIs), and tonsillitis.

German doctors often administer OPSONAT as a "first prescription" remedy for acute patients, especially younger, fairly healthy adults (age 20 to



40) with dysfunctions in the musculoskeletal system where inflammation and pain are present. However, OPSONAT is also a highly useful "add-on" medication in frail, sensitive, and chronically ill patient populations. Therefore, it is recommended that practitioners who treat chronic conditions start with low doses (1 to 5 drops) of OPSONAT, and slowly increase up to a standard dosage of 10 to 15 drops taken twice per day in water.

By acting as a catalyst, OPSONAT combines extremely well with all PEKANA organ-specific remedies. Common combinations include OPSONAT with 1) apo-STOM for gastritis; 2) with apo-ENTERIT for symptoms of irritable bowel; 3) with AKUTUR for acute urological infections; 4) with SEPTONSIL for tonsillitis; and 5) with RICURA for sinusitis and rhinitis.
